- Information on personal data processing -

1. Data concerning the personal data controller

For the performance of the Campaign, the personal data of the attendants will be processed by:

Kronospan Foundation, with the headquarters in Braşov, Str. Strunga Mieilor, nr. 1, judeţul Braşov, cod poştal 500482, tax registration number 29167440, registered in the Registrar of Associations and Foundations of the Registry of the Court of Braşov under no. 85/2011 (hereinafter referred to as the “Organiser”). 2. Categories of personal data processed within the Campaign

Within the Campaign, the Foundation will collect from the attendants the following categories of personal data:

- (i) last name and first name of the applicant to the Campaign;
- (ii) last name and first name of the guardian/parent of the minor applicant to the Campaign;
- (iii) e-mail address;
- (iv) phone number
- (v) country of origin of the applicant to the Campaign

3. Purpose of processing

The personal data of the Campaign attendants will be processed by the Company directly in order to:

- (i) organise and perform “**skill.ED**” (“the Campaign”);
- (ii) inform you on future events of Kronospan Foundation.

The Campaign attendants will not be established by automated means of data processing, without human intervention.

4. Transfer of personal data

The personal data collected by the Foundation within the Campaign will be disclosed in the cases when the Foundation must observe the obligations imposed by the valid law (respectively tax authorities).

5. Period of storage of personal data

The personal data of the attendants who are declared non-attendant will be stored by the Foundation in accordance with the privacy policy adopted by the Foundation.

6. Rights of data subjects

In order to ensure a fair and transparent processing, the Foundation grants the attendants throughout the Campaign the following rights:

- (i) right of withdrawal of consent to processing, at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on the consent prior to its withdrawal;
- (ii) right of access to personal data;
- (iii) right to rectification of personal data;
- (iv) right to erasure of personal data or restriction of processing;
- (v) right to object to processing, except when legal provisions set for otherwise;
- (vi) right to data portability;
- (vii) right to lodge a complaint with the National Supervisory Authority for Personal Data Processing.

Except for the right to lodge a complaint with the National Supervisory Authority for Personal Data Processing, the attendants have the right to exercise the aforesaid rights directly or through the guardian/parent/holder of the parent authority, by means of a written, dated and signed request submitted to the Company using the contact data stated under article 1 above.

7. Safety of personal data

The Foundation undertakes to implement adequate technical and organisation measures in order to ensure an appropriate level of safety of the personal data of the Campaign attendants. At the assessment of the appropriate safety level the Foundation shall consider in particular the risks related to the processing of personal data, generated in particular, accidentally or illegally, by the

destruction, loss, alteration, unauthorised disclosure or unauthorised access to the submitted, stored or processed personal data.

8. Other provisions

The personal data of the Campaign attendants will be processed in accordance with the provisions of the Regulation no. 679/2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC and other legal provisions in the field of personal data protection.
